
ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF PRACTICE

as Antagonize, is a Filipinoborn, Melbourne/Naarm-based
multidisciplinary artist, DJ, and
respected community leader in the
"Burn City Krump" scene.



A dynamic force in Melbourne's underground and arts scenes, Antagonize moves fluidly between the dance floor and the DJ booth. As one of the prominent figures in Burn City Krump, he has trained under global pioneers of the style—including Tight Eyez in Los Angeles—and performed on major stages like Asia TOPA, World of Dance LA, Grounded: Battle of the Arts, and Masters of Choreography. His dedication extends beyond performance; Antagonize is passionately committed to preserving and teaching Krump culture, empowering the next generation of dancers through mentorship, workshops, and events. Always evolving, Antagonize stands as a bold representative of movement, rhythm, and culture—dedicated to inspiring others while staying true to his roots and artistic journey.



We are L2R Dance, Australia's only youth-led, hip hop and street dance not-for-profit and social enterprise, based in Footscray. Driven by the creativity and ambition of our young people, we use dance to challenge power dynamics, dissolve barriers, and build powerful intersections between great art and social impact.

Embedded in Melbourne's West, L2R delivers free weekly dance programs, creative development, leadership training and employment pathways for children and young people from newly arrived, refugee, migrant and low socio-economic backgrounds. Our collaborative model centres the lived experience and creative ambitions of communities navigating financial pressures and complex identities.

We believe in the power of dance to build belonging, spark self-expression, and create fun, engaging and lifelong opportunities for young people. Our professional dance works are bold, contemporary, and driven by the pulse of global street culture, created by and for young people who shape them in real time.

Our vision is for an Australia where everyone, regardless of background or postcode, can access a joyful, creative life. We believe creativity, fun and cultural connection are universal rights, not

L2R's Igniting Legends Program is a six month paid internship for young people connected to the dance, hip hop, and street dance communities, just like you!

It's designed for emerging leaders who have demonstrated curiosity, commitment, and the potential to grow. The program supports the development of employment pathways, strengthens artistic skills, and nurtures career aspirations in the creative industries.



At its core, Igniting Legends builds the capacity of young dancers to step into leadership roles within L2R and the broader community, fostering bright futures, exploring the world through dance, and championing creativity as a powerful tool for change.

Established in 2018 to support members graduating from Year 12 and or those looking to explore education through unconventional education systems, the program has become an integral part of L2R and our commitment to youth leadership, sustainable pathways and employment. It ensures our future leaders are representative of the communities we engage and that young people have a strong voice in shaping L2R's programs and outcomes.

A key to the program's success is L2R's ability to stay flexible and responsive to the ideas, needs, and concerns of young people. We're proud to play a role in the early stages of each young artist's creative journey, and excited to see them flourish and take it wherever they choose to go. Let's go!



APPLICATION PROCESS

Potential Legends are required to complete a simple Expression of Interest Form (or video submission). Emerging Artists are selected through this process and then appointed by Jacinda Richards (CEO) and Hëna Memishi (Igniting Legends Coordinator).

COMMITMENT

The Igniting Legends program runs every Thursday for 6 hours per week and is a paid internship.

- Weekly sessions will primarily take place at L2R HQ in Footscray.
- Participants may also be required to attend events, workshops, and meetings at various locations across Melbourne, as arranged in consultation Creative Producer H\u00e4na Memishi.


